

How to Configure Dialup Networking with Windows 2000

Step 1: Begin Network Connection Wizard

1. Click on the Start menu
2. Go to Settings | Network and Dial-up Connections
3. This will open a folder called Make New Connection
4. Double click the Make New Connection folder to begin the Network Connection Wizard
5. Click Next

Step 2: Begin Internet Connection Wizard

1. Under Network Connection Type, select Dial-up to the Internet
2. Click Next
3. This will open the Internet Connection Wizard
4. Choose the third selection (to set up connection manually)
5. Click Next
6. Enter the phone number of the desired Point-of-Presence (POP)

Step 3: Internet Account Logon Information

If DNS is not yet configured, perform steps 1 through 9, and 11 through 20.

If DNS has been configured, perform steps 10 through 20.

1. Click Advanced
2. Select PPP (Point-to-Point Protocol) under Connection Type
3. Select None under Logon Procedure
4. Click Addresses
5. Under IP address select "Internet service provider automatically provides one."
6. Under DNS server address select "My ISP automatically provides a Domain Name Server (DNS) address."
7. Click OK
8. Click Next
9. Enter User Name (account ID)
10. Enter Password
11. Select Next
12. Name the connection (whatever name you would like)
13. Select Next
14. Answer No to the question concerning the setup of a mail client
15. Click Finish
16. The Network and Dial-up Connections folder will list an icon with your new configuration name
17. Double click on the icon to begin dialing
18. Windows 2000 configuration is now complete
